Executive Summary

This Interim Report is assessing some opportunities for British experts and businesses engaged with science & innovation, with reference to cities, mobility and climate action in the particular region of Danube Delta, Romania.

The report is setting the scene with reference to two main cities: Tulcea and Sulina and illustrates topics linked to decarbonisation: climate, energy, mobility, biodiversity.

A particular focus is given to the Mobility Framework (developed by the author), acting as an action oriented tool which incorporates information on *policies and local strategies, governance* on carbon decision making, *human investment* and skills. Information on *financial resources & business case* clarifies existing *funding instruments* and opportunities for investment, while knowledge on *data and innovations* indicate ways to operate this Framework. Evidence on *infrastructure* and *capacity building* is complementing the type of information needed to be captured in order to identify opportunities for engagement and investment in Danube Delta's cities and communities engaged with an integrated mobility.

The Report indicates ways to link the present findings to local, national and European initiatives. Particular reference is given to Sulina- to explore opportunities for research and business community, built upon existing needs and British legacy in the region.

The next step will include the Framework being tested in an expert meeting roundable and clear opportunities indicated.
